I cast my mind back when we began on the 7th of January 2019. A simple act of obedience when three of us gathered to pray at 6am on a chilly winter morning in the church building. The initial goal was to do that over the period of the Daniel Fast. As others heard of it and joined it steadily grew with over thirty different people meeting physically in the building by the end of January. After the fast the overwhelming sense was that the Lord wanted us to continue and there was a desire to commit to it. This went on with numbers fluctuating up until physical gatherings stopped due to the pandemic. We quickly took it online and it grew to a consistent number for lengthy periods of time. At the time writing this it is now almost 2100 days of corporate daily prayer and devotion.

My encouragement to you all is that you continue to be steadfast and unmovable always abounding in the work of the Lord knowing that your labour of love in the Lord will not be in vain (1 Corinthians 15:58).

Finally, to you man and woman of God, flee from the love of money, pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness. Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of eternal life to which you were called. 1 Timothy 6:11-12.

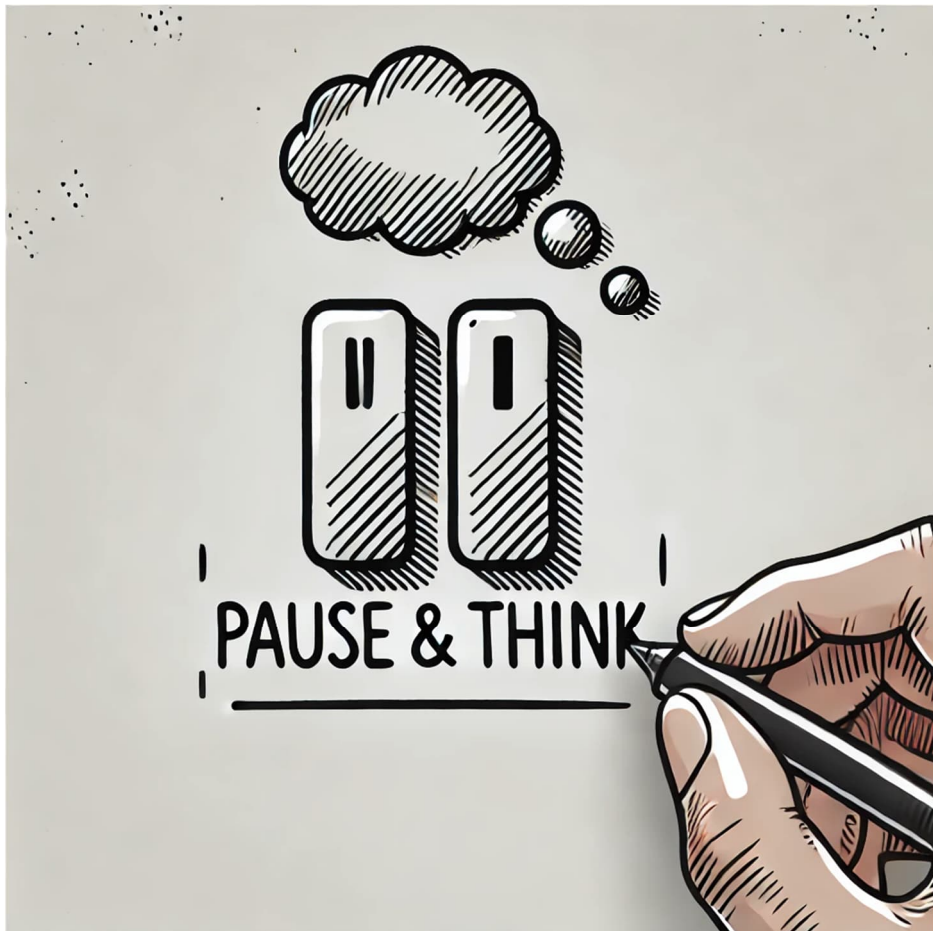
